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COMMITMENT- PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

A. Attendance: Leadership Glendale is a learning experience that requires a substantial time commitment. To qualify for graduation, a class member **MUST** attend the Orientation and Opening Session, a minimum of six (of eight) regular classes and participate in the Class Project. Further absences may be forgiven on a case-by-case basis.

Schedule for the Class of 2011:

Opening session -- Friday & Saturday, October 15-16, 2010 (partial day on Saturday)

Wednesday classes -- November 3 and 17, December 8, **2010**; January 12, February 9, March 9, April 13, May 11, **2011**

Class project retreat – To be decided by the class

Commencement – Wednesday, May 11, 2011 (Late afternoon, early evening)

The Chamber will make every effort to maintain the above schedule. If changes are necessary, class will be notified well in advance.

TUITION & DEPOSIT

- **Early Application Discount** -- \$1,000 if application (with deposit) is received at the Chamber by **Friday, September 24, 2010**
- **Standard Tuition** -- \$1,200. (See final application deadline below.)
- **Deposit** – A deposit of \$200 (refundable if *not* accepted into program) must accompany application unless other arrangements are made. Tuition covers all class sessions, workshop-resource materials, meals and miscellaneous costs unless announced in advance.

C. Employer/Organization Support: Due to the time commitment, applicants for Leadership Glendale must receive the support of their employer and/or sponsoring business or organization. A supervisor's signature below is required to verify support.

D. Financial 'Scholarship': Applicants may be considered for financial support, up to a \$250 scholarship. Early application discount applicants also may qualify for the scholarship. If you or your business/organization cannot fully cover tuition and you are seeking financial alternatives, please check here: _____.

E. Candidates for Public Office: Applicants who are seeking public office at the time of application will not be considered for enrollment in the program. This restriction does not apply to persons already elected or appointed and/or serving in office at the time of application.
